Normal: horse does not possess the mutation associated with CA.

Normal: horse does not have the LFS gene.

No copies of the OAAM mutation; horse is normal.

No copies of the SCID mutation; horse is normal.

### What Do These Results Mean for a Mare Owner?

These results mean that RA Nocturne is **NOT** a carrier for any of these recessive genetic traits. It also means that you as a mare owner, do not need to test your mare before you breed to RA Nocturne.

If your mare is a carrier of one of these traits, which means that she carries one copy of the gene/mutation, there is a 25% chance that a foal born of this mating will also be a carrier.

There is **NO CHANCE** that a foal would have the disease/mutation.

This means that you can safely breed any mare to RA Nocturne without worrying about any health issues for the resulting foal.

### What Does Homozygous Black Mean to a Mare Owner?

Imagine breeding a black mare to a black stallion and having a chestnut foal. You might be wondering; how did this happen? The answer lies in coat color genetics.

A homozygous black stallion means that he cannot produce a chestnut horse, no matter what color the mare is. This is because the black gene is dominant to the red gene and will always overrule it.

It does not, however, guarantee you a black foal. The agouti gene determines if the black is spread across the body or restricted to the points (i.e., mane, tail, feet, etc.). For example, you breed a bay mare to RA Nocturne, if the mare has 2 copies of the agouti gene, the foal will be bay, if the mare has only 1 copy of the agouti gene, there is a 50% chance of having a black foal.

### CLASS DEFINITIONS:

#### EGYPTIAN RELATED

One parent, dam or sire, must be Straight Egyptian.

#### EGYPTIAN HERITAGE

One Straight Egyptian in the first four generations of the pedigree. Percentages of blood as a qualifier will usually not be accepted.

#### STRAIGHT EGYPTIAN

Recognized as Straight Egyptian by The Pyramid Society of the United States.
